Lab evaluations are completed each February; this includes CTE programs with labs, academic disciplines that utilize labs, and computer labs not assigned to a particular program or discipline. The form is used to evaluate the condition of the facility, equipment, and supplies. 10 programs made requests for improvement/repairs to the labs or requested additional space; the solutions for most of the requests will be resolved when the renovation of CC is completed. The complete list of requests was forwarded to the Dean of Instructional Services.

Inventories of major equipment items and computers are updated.

Additionally, the form is used to identify equipment, materials, supplies, and furnishings needed to deliver high-quality instruction.

For 2011-2012, 13 CTE programs requests for equipment, technology, and curriculum materials totaled \$187,101. Two academic disciplines using labs submitted evaluations; the only request was the need to replace the chemistry lab flooring in the near future.

Use of data:

The information from the Lab Evaluation reports is used to plan maintenance and repair of facilities, to analyze use of the facilities, and to plan for optimum use. The inventory lists include timelines for replacement of equipment. This is especially useful for planning the cycle for computer replacement.

CTE programs and academic disciplines use the evaluation reports for preparing budget requests in March. Also, they are used for developing the Perkins Basic grant activities and budgets.
