Highlights of data: The THECB Licensure Report attempts to collect licensure/certification data for all programs (credit) listed in the program inventory. Requested information includes:

- Licensure, certification, both or not available
- Program information for how many students tested and how many passed during the academic year
- Individual student information including SSN, tested/passed
- Agency reporting data, student self-report, both or NA

Ten programs at Vernon College reported licensure/certification requirements with 277 students testing and 254 passing.

It should be noted that the Vernon College Key Performance of Accountability for licensure/certification pass rate includes continuing education programs as well as credit.

Use of data: The THECB plans to use this report in various student success and excellence measures. It will also be sharing the information with the Legislative Budget Board for its annual report. Licensure/certification is a Vernon College Key Performance Indicator of Accountability used to measure student success.
