Highlights of data:

Perkins Basic grant funds are to be used to improve the quality of CTE and increase student participation and success. The first quarter of the Perkins Basic Grant year reported progress on each assessment objective. Funds were expended on professional development travel for 10 CTE faculty and staff; equipment, software, curriculum materials to upgrade the CTE curriculum; and child care assistance and brochures for Special Services. Faculty who participated in professional development are submitting brief descriptions of how the activity will be used to improve instruction.

Two major challenges to meet the assessment objectives are increasing the number students who are the under-represented gender enrolled in and successful in gender-biased programs. The goal is to increase enrollment and completion of gender-biased students by 2 percent annually until the goal of 25 percent is accomplished.
