Highlights of data:

Perkins Basic grant funds are to be used to improve the quality of CTE programs and increase student participation and success. The 3d quarter of the Perkins Basic Grant year reported progress on each assessment objective. Perkins funds were expended for 6 CTE faculty and staff to attend professional development activities; equipment, software, curriculum materials to upgrade the CTE curriculum were purchased for Industrial Automation Systems, HVAC, Pharmacy Technician, LVN, ADN, and Surgical Technology; and brochures and posters featuring gender equity are being designed.

The Gender Equity Subcommittee met on March 10 and recommended activities for promoting gender equity in the CTE programs.
