



This monthly report is intended to provide the Vernon College Board of Trustees, Vernon College Foundation Board members, as well as college faculty and staff, with updated information regarding significant college activities, issues, and accomplishments.

#### College Governance – Dr. Dusty R. Johnston

- The Vernon College Board of Trustees accepted and approved the 2009-2010 audit prepared by Edgin, Parkman, Fleming, and Fleming, PC of Wichita Falls, Texas. The financial component of the audit was excellent. The process component of the audit cited many improvements in the past year to ongoing internal processes that had previously been cited for improvement. One current year process in financial aid was identified as needing improvement. A corrective action letter has already been submitted.
- The Board also approved the architectural plans for the Century City Center renovation project. According to the timeline presented by Rick Sims, the schematics and bid documents should be completed by April, bids should be opened in May, and renovation should begin in June.
- All state agencies, including universities and community colleges, received notification from the state that the current year appropriated funds would be reduced by an additional 2.5%. This amounts to \$147,421 for Vernon College. This will come from funds budgeted as contingency in the 2010-2011 approved budget.
- State funding for Vernon College for next biennium is estimated to be reduced by as much as \$1.4 million per year because of the state budget shortfall. The final number will result from the decisions made during the upcoming legislative session. The administrative team has already scrutinized the current 2010-2011 budget for potential cost savings as we begin to develop the 2011-2012 budget. As all employees participate in the upcoming budget process, all expenses need to be analyzed thoroughly and all revenue options need to be explored.
- Many of the new processes and procedures put in to place due to recommendations of the Academic Advising Task Force; including the use of Course Scheduling Advisors (CSA) appear to have been met with positive attitudes by the students who participated in pre-registration for the spring 2011 semester. It was very encouraging to see the volume of returning students take advantage of the advising opportunities.
- The rodeo alumni reception hosted at the Wrangler National Finals Rodeo in Las Vegas, Nevada was a success. Twelve former Vernon College rodeo team members qualified for the WNFR out of total possible 105 slots. We were honored to have world champions Will Lowe, Stran Smith, Rich Skelton, and the new all-time leader in all-around cowboy world championships, Trevor Brazile, join us for the reception. Many other alumni, as well as employees and friends of the college also on hand to help make the event a success. Sponsors of the reception were the Vernon College Board of Trustees, the Vernon College Foundation, Kieschnick Insurance, the Santa Rosa Roundup committee, Mr. and Mrs. Grady Stowe, and Mr. Joe Chat Sumner. The support was greatly appreciated.
