

July Update

This monthly report is intended to provide the Vernon College Board of Trustees, Vernon College Foundation Board members, as well as college faculty and staff, with updated information regarding significant college activities, issues, and accomplishments.

College Governance - Dr. Dusty R. Johnston

- State funding and the 2011-2012 college budget have been on the priority list for several months. The dust has settled from the legislative session and we have some pretty solid numbers for state funding for Vernon College in regard to formula instructional appropriations, health insurance appropriations, and retirement appropriations. The basic state funding for instructional funds increased because of the significant 29.6% contact hour growth from the last funding cycle. The appropriation increased from a revised 2010-11 biennial appropriation of \$10,970,330 to a final 2012-2013 biennial appropriation of \$11,699,859. Unfortunately, the state funding for group health insurance and retirement funds decreased by an estimate of \$1.1 million dollars for the biennium. To continue supporting group health insurance and retirement matching for employees, the College will be absorbing just over \$400 per employee per month in cost that has been paid by dedicated state funding in past years. As the 2011-2012 Vernon College budget is being finalized, the most significant changes from the 2010-2011 budget are:
 - Increased tuition and fee revenue resulting from increases in tuition and fee rates
 - o Increase instructional formula funds due to contact hour growth
 - Cost to the budget for decrease in group health insurance and retirement funds
 - Cost of two additional faculty positions (English, History)
 - Elimination of two full time positions possible due to retirements (Associate Dean of Administrative Services, Grounds Technician)
 - o Reduction in capital project funds in Vernon and Wichita Falls
 - Reduction in capital outlay funds throughout the budget
 - Reduction in technology funds throughout the budget
 - Reduction in supply funds throughout the budget
 - Reduction in contingency funds
- Century City Center renovation plans are continuing to be finalized. The revised date for opening the project bids is September 1, 2011. A great deal of work and thought has gone into the renovation plans. Everyone's contribution is greatly appreciated.
- The baseball field expansion/renovation project is 99.5% complete. Plans are being made for an early fall dedication and open house.
- An outside firm will be conducting an in-depth audit of all Information Technology infrastructure, functions, processes, and practices during the month of July. Please provide your supervisor with input in regard to how you interact with IT. Various administrators and employees will be interviewed during the audit process. The primary goal of the audit is to identify strengths and weakness to assist in future planning to enhance the IT component of the institution.
- The President's office is working with Advancement and Institutional Effectiveness to produce an annual President's Report to the Community. The Institutional Profile and the Key Performance Indicators of Accountability (KPIAs) will be the cornerstones of the report. Additional facts and accomplishments will be added to give a very good overview of the past year's activities to the community.

- I have appointed another Improvement Task Force call the Community Interaction Task Force. This year, we will focus on the Vernon campus and then next year we will have a similar task force in Wichita Falls. The primary purposes of the Task Force to make recommendations which will (1) ensure optimum community interaction with the Vernon campus of Vernon College, (2)encourage more community people to be on campus, and (3) highlight opportunities for Vernon College to be a location to facilitate community interaction. Vickie Bradley and Christie Lehman will be co-chairing the Task Force and the group will begin to meet when schools starts in August.
- Congratulations to the Vernon College Rodeo Team for another highly successful season.

- **10 Surgical Technology students** accompanied Program Coordinator & Instructor **Jeff Feix**, to the 2011 *AST National Conference* held in San Francisco June 1-5. While there, students attended the student forums and Jeff coordinated the AST Community Outreach event which entailed volunteering at the meal center for the GLIDE organization where they assisted in feeding 750 homeless people on Memorial Day.
- An online training version for Blackboard Learn (Bb 9.1) is currently underway with 18 faculty participating. Another online session will be offered July 11- August 7. The online training was developed by Roxie Hill, Instructional Design & Technology Coordinator. To date, 72 instructors have participated in trainings with the goal of having all current online instructors trained prior to the fall semester when Vernon College will officially transition from Bb version 8 to the new Blackboard version 9.1.




Finance/Administrative Services/Physical Plant - Garry David
