Neither formal questionnaire nor survey was administered in the Spring of 2012.

A Quality Enhancement Resource Inventory survey was administered to faculty in August 2012. The survey was administered for inquiry on current use of educational technologies (ET) and/or interests in incorporating ET into teaching or support services. Professional developments would be presented on an individual and/or departmental format based on the results.

Use of data:

The data suggested that while faculty is interested in new technologies they are more interested with the engagement and instructional strategies that support the use of ET in the classroom. This fall the focus for Professional Development aligns with the instructional strategies and suggestive interventions as defined in the Student Instructional Report II Survey (SIR II).
