Survey is sent to all Vernon College students who took part in academic coaching in the Fall semester. Below are the responses Spring 2016 and 2015 for comparison.

Use of data: The data shows consistent positive feedback from students who participated in the academic support service-academic coaching. From year to year 100% of students reported they felt they understood what it takes to be successful in college, and would recommend the service to another student who is struggling in class (validity). Data also illustrates efforts and contact with students made to encourage students to participate in Academic Coaching. Title III/Student Services will continue to use this data to plan our outreach to at-risk as well as all students and to work with other departments to identify students who can benefit from academic coaching.

How associated to Student Success? This snapshot shows that our targeted interventions with at risk students continue to increase in number and effort and are successfully exposing students to proven study habits in a positive setting and increasing their odds at persistence and success.
