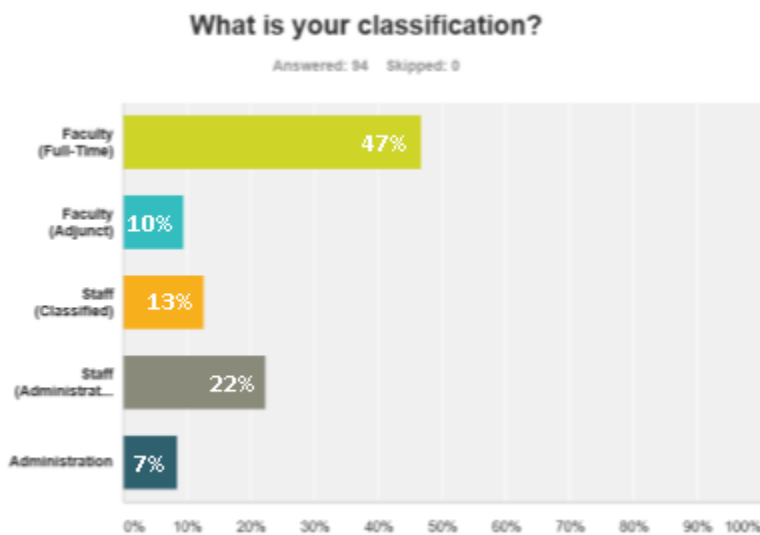
**Title:** QERI Survey

**Highlights of data:**

The Quality Enhancement Resource Inventory (QERI) Survey was administered to faculty and staff in December 2016. 94 respondents completed the survey. The survey was conducted to determine what resources are being used and what training is needed to continue to effectively use educational technology tools.



Employees were asked how often educational technology tools were used to support instruction or job responsibilities. The following are the most used resources based on survey results.

**QERI TOP 10**

1. Cell phone for text messaging
2. Presentation software (e.g., Powerpoint)
3. Cell phone for web browsing or applications
4. Streaming videos (e.g., You Tube, Helix)
5. Laptop/Surface Tablet
6. Audio/video clips
7. iPad
8. Digital camera (including cell phone or iPad camera)
9. Video conferencing (e.g., Bb Collaborate, Skype, Facetime)
10. Camcorder (including webcam, cell phone or iPad camcorder)

The following tools showed the largest percent increase in usage from 2014.

1. Survey tools (e.g., Survey Monkey, Google Docs)
2. Camcorder (including webcam, cell phone or iPad camcorder)
3. Streaming videos (e.g., You Tube, Helix)
4. Video conferencing (e.g., Bb Collaborate, Skype, Facetime)

7. Cell phone for web browsing or applications
8. Laptop/Surface Tablet
