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**Use of data:**

The data from this report is combined with other THECB data on local graduates to determine graduate placement rate for the Vernon College. The more graduates who are located in employment, the military, or in higher education, the higher the graduate placement rate. Follow-up information for students is documented in the THECB Accountability System and Perkins Data Resources (used to determine Perkins Funding). The current minimum Institutional Effectiveness placement standard for technical programs is 85% of completers over a three year period. This information is reported in the related Vernon College Key Performance Indicator of Accountability.

**How associated to Student Success?** Student Success at Vernon College is exemplified through retention, completion of a certificate or associate degree and/or successful transfer to a four year university. Success is also recognized as placement into the workforce for our graduates. The CBM 116-Follow-up Report includes persistence and employment/military for graduates reported to the THECB by Vernon College.
