Title: ESCR Data Fall 2016

Date of completion: February 2017

Highlights of data: The benchmark for student achievement of core objectives at Vernon College is set at 75%. Instructors reported attainment over 75% for all six core objectives. All but one objective, empirical/quantitative skills, showed achievement of over 82%.

Use of data: Instructor professional development and curricular changes at the department and course level are driven by the instructors' reflections when completing the ESCR. Instructors completed 104 unique ESCRs during Fall 2016.

How associated to Student Success? Using core objective attainment level and grade distributions, instructors reflect on student success across all six core objectives and course level learning outcomes. Individual reflection and departmental discussion act as catalysts for curricular changes at the course level and increased student success on objectives.
