Highlights of data:

The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board 2018 Licensure Report required institutions to report the number of students who were tested and the number of students who passed from September 1, 2016 through August 31, 2017. Vernon College extends this collection for the Licensure/Certification Rate Key Performance Indicator of Accountability (KPIA) to include any program where students complete a licensure or certification exam.

Use of data:

The Licensure/Certification KPIA Benchmark selected by Vernon College is *at or above state performance target of 85% success rate: Source Perkins Program Measures Statewide Target*. The benchmark results are used for program improvement discussion. Two of the uses for the THECB Report are Perkin's funding considerations and the THECB Accountability Report measures. The information is also included on the Legislative Budget Board Report.
