The Transportation Industry is growing and there is a high demand for well-trained drivers. This five-week course utilizes state-of-the-art simulator training, classroom instruction, range and road driving, and practical application of skills used in the operation of a tractor-trailer. The truck-driving course prepares students to complete the written exams and the driving exam necessary to receive a Class A Commercial Driver's License (CDL). The course meets all Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration guidelines. Students who successfully complete the entire course will receive a class "A" Commercial Driver License, a certificate of completion and be qualified to secure an entry-level job as a Commercial Motor Vehicle driver.

# Class Times:

### Registration:

- A student may enroll in an upcoming Truck Driving course to reserve their seat.
- Payment for FULL tuition or proof of funding is required upon registration.
- Student must be 18 years of age at the commencement of the course.
- Copy of the students valid/current Drivers License is required at registration.

### **Requirements Prior to the Start of Class:**

- 1. Student is required to have a DOT physical (Department of Transportation Medical Card) and clean drug screen completed prior to class. Cost of the physical and drug screen is not included. Please note that per federal guidelines, drug screen results must be within 30 days of the start of class.
- 2. Student must also have a copy of a driving record obtained through the Texas DPS office with at least 3 years of driving history. The record can be obtained online at How to Order a Driver Record | Department of Public Safety.
- 3. Students MUST turn in all documents to the Continuing Education Office or email them to truckdriving@vernoncollege.edu ten days prior to the start of class.

Tuition: \$4,000 (Week 1: \$500 / Week 2-5: \$3,500)
