Certified Nurse Aide ~ CNA Program ~

In this entry-level course, Nursing Assistants can gain the knowledge, skills, and competencies essential to providing basic care to residents of long-term care facilities. The 116 hour course topics include resident rights and safety, reporting, observation, effective communication, effective interaction with the health care team, assisting residents in maintaining basic comfort and personal care.

STUDENT REQUIREMENTS:

SOCIAL SECURITY CARD, A VALID PHOTO ID, AND COMPLETE SHOT RECORD REQUIRED TO REGISTER

- Minimum age 16 and no criminal <u>convictions</u> or probation
- Have no physical restrictions and be able to lift and move residents
- Competent communication skills (speaking, reading, & writing) / Instruction provided in English
- Current Shot Records as required by the Department of State Health Services at the time of enrollment

 MMR (2): Tetanus (<10 years): Varicella (2): and Hepatitis B Series (2 of 3 doses must be completed)}
- Book and workbook are required at first class meeting
- Attendance is mandatory Must complete 64 hours of 72 hour course, plus 44 clinical hours (no exceptions!)
- Clinical: scrubs, shoes & watch (with a second hand) required when Clinical begins. Picture name tag; you will be notified in class when pictures will be taken and when Clinical will begin

If you have a revoked Nurse Aide License, you will not be permitted to take the state certification exam. This information will be verified before the exam is scheduled.
