Intravenous Therapy-Theory & Techniques

Prerequisites: Must be a LVN or healthcare professional
This course teaches the basic theory and techniques of venipuncture, continuous and intermittent intravenous infusions and intra-osseous infusion techniques. Emphasis is on medication administration techniques, venous system physiology, appropriate anatomical site selection, rapid identification of localized and systemic complications of intravenous therapy and methods to decrease infiltration, infection, and extravasation rates associated with intravenous therapy.


