Must complete 64 hours of 72 hour course, and 44 clinical hours. **Students must provide valid photo ID, SS card, and up-to-date immunization records when registering.**

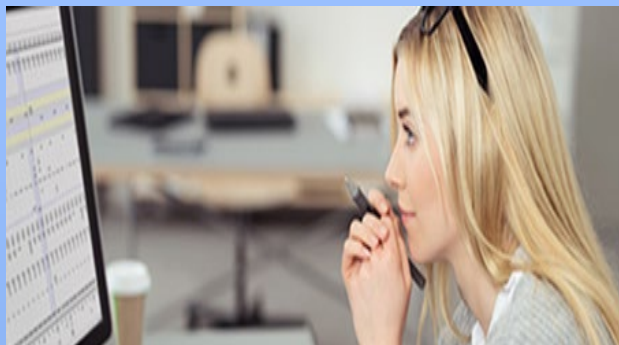

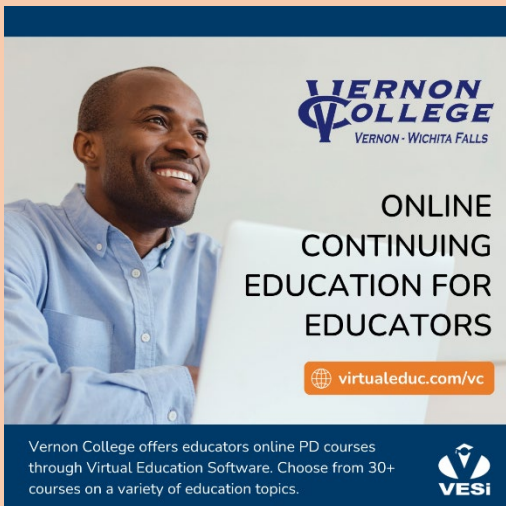
