Phlebotomy Certification

The **Phlebotomy Certification** program is a **marketable skills program** that generates an **institutional certificate.**Upon successful completion of Phlebotomy I & II, you will have the opportunity to take a national certification exam.

PHLEBOTOMY I

Students engage in 64 hours of instruction and training to draw blood on manikin arms and hands.

REQUIREMENTS:

Minimum age 18 with completed High School Diploma or High School Equivalency
No criminal convictions or probation
Communicate effectively/instruction provided in English

Attendance is mandatory - if you miss more than two class meetings, you may be dismissed from the course and therefore will not pass the course

Manual dexterity / Good hygiene & health No artificial/sculptured nails or nail tips

CPR Card before clinicals

Student must provide current shot records at time of enrollment, as required by the DEPARTMENT of STATE HEALTH SERVICES (MMR, TD, Varicella, TB and Hepatitis B (Series of 3)

PHLEBOTOMY II

The students engage in a minimum of 64 hours of classroom instruction and 60 hours of clinical (must be available during daytime hours), which require dedication due to the length of time the student is developing the skills necessary for drawing blood at various clinical sites. Please note that you will meet in class once a week, and your clinical schedule will be assigned based on facility accommodations and availability.

Successful completion of the Phlebotomy I course Navy Blue Scrubs & picture ID badge
