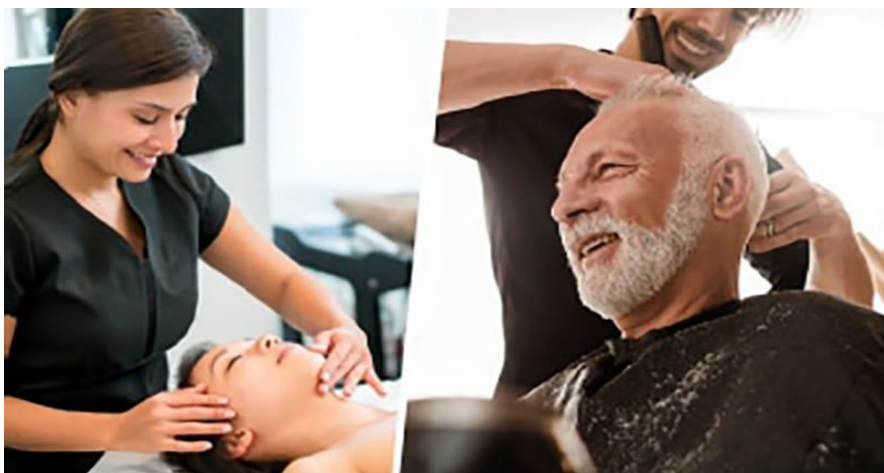


COSMETOLOGY BARBER



A Cosmetologist specializes in the styling of hair, including cutting and chemical services such as relaxers, texturizers, perms, and color, as well as restorative treatments. In addition, a Class A Barber specializes in the cutting of hair using clippers, shears and razor. Students in both programs will learn about salon development to help with the business management of their practice as well. Upon successful completion of the program, graduates will be eligible to take the examination prescribed by the State Licensing agency to become a Licensed Cosmetologist or Barber.

- 9 months – Certificate of Completion

- Cosmetology - Wichita Falls Century City Center & Vernon campus
- Barber – Wichita Falls Century City Center only

When does the program start?

- Fall, Spring and Summer

- Barber – Mon-Thurs - 4:00 pm to 10:00 pm

To be admitted to the Cosmetology/Barber program:

- Complete Vernon College application. Students must be accepted by the college before being considered for the Cosmetology program. Admission to the college does not guarantee enrollment in the program. Submit the following documentation for Vernon College acceptance:
 - High school or college transcripts
 - Proof of Bacterial Meningitis vaccination
 - Residency documentation (see application)
- Complete a Cosmetology Program Application Packet. Submit completed packet directly to the Cosmetology Dept. Programs are *first come, first served* and there is often a waiting list for admission.
- Acceptance letters will be mailed.
- New students **must** attend the New Student Group Advising session (TBA)
- Register and pay tuition and fees by deadline
