Coaching & Scholarship

Participating students are paired with an oncampus Client Navigator to assist them in reaching their goals.

Students accepted into our program will receive one of the two following scholarships. Decisions are based on an interview, eligibility, financial need, and available funds.

- Last Dollar Tuition and Book Scholarship: This covers up to ½ of tuition (maximum) for your approved degree (after all other grants/scholarships are exhausted) & up to \$750 per semester for required books.
- Full Ride Vernon College Tuition and Book Scholarship. Limited spots. Covers all tuition and books. Wichita Falls campus only.
