- 1. Eligible returning candidates will be reviewed and offered scholarships once the Spring 2022 grades have been turned in and the grade point averages (gpas) recalculated (about mid-May).
- 2. Eligible applicants will have a grade point average of at least 3.0, unless otherwise stated in the scholarship criteria, and completion of at least 25% of the student's Certificate program or Associate Degree or at least 12 credit hours, excluding all Development course hours.

d) Out of State Students

e) Athletic Scholarships

It is proposed that the Vernon College Student Scholarship/Financial Aid Committee approve the awarding of 2022-2023 competitive athletic scholarships by the Athletic Director based upon the recommendations of the four NJCAA/NIRA head coaches. The maximum number of scholarships that may be awarded by each sport will comply with the constituted rules of the NJCAA/NIRA governing bodies. Additionally, these recommendations will also be submitted to the President of the College for approval and the President will subsequently report these to the Vernon College Board of Trustees on an annual basis.

Action: Ms. Harris moved approval; seconded by Mr. Feix. The motion carried unanimously.

f) Scholarship Subcommittee

It is proposed that a Subcommittee of the Vernon College Student Scholarship/Financial Aid Committee be appointed to award the 2022-2023 Scholarships and that this subcommittee can use their discretion to make these awards as they deem necessary.
