b) Returning Students, Non- Nursing

Available Funds \$222,709

Nursing students, both ADN and LVN, are excluded from this applicant pool because both programs have restricted Nursing Scholarships. Scholarship offers will be made to eligible candidates based upon the following guidelines depending upon the final availability of funds.

- 1. Eligible returning candidates will be reviewed and offered scholarships once the Spring 2023 grades have been turned in and the grade point averages (gpa) recalculated (about mid-May).
- 2. Eligible applicants will have a grade point average of at least 3.0, unless otherwise stated in the Scholarship criteria, and completion of at least 25% of the student's Certificate program or Associate Degree or at least 12 credit hours, excluding all Development course hours.
