Things to Consider ...

■ **TUITION:** Wayland strives to keep its tuition rates affordable for students. For the most current tuition rates, see the WBU website or the current academic catalog.

■ **TERMS:** The Wichita Falls campus offers four 11-week terms each year, with registration typically held the three weeks prior to the start of classes each term. Classes primarily meet in the evenings and on weekends to make working around jobs and family obligations easier.

■ **ACADEMIC ADVISING:** Advising is available at our offices from 7:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday and 8:00 a.m. to 12 p.m. on Friday. Advisors can help you draft a degree plan and design a class schedule around your busy life.

■ **FINANCIAL AID:** Wayland's staff of

advisors can share options to finance your education, including military tuition assistance, VA benefits, federal aid and more.

■ **CREDIT FOR WORK:** In many cases, your work experience can be accepted as professional development credit – up to 12 hours – toward a bachelor's degree at Wayland. Ask our advisors about getting credit for work you've already done.

■ **INTERNET OPTIONS:** If you are familiar with the Internet, you may benefit from courses taken via WBU Online. More than 200 sections per term cover offerings from each academic school.

Assignments, notes, slide presentations, and class resources are made available via the Internet. Interaction between the instructor and students is done by e-mail, threaded message boards, and chat rooms.

Getting Started ...

So what does it take to begin the journey toward an education at Wayland? Here are the basics:

■ **FIRST-TIME ENROLLMENT:** If you have never attended college, you will need official transcripts from your high school and official scores from the ACT or SAT. If you are over age 22, test scores are not required but are encouraged, as high marks may qualify you for college credit. Admission application fee is \$35.

■ **TRANSFER STUDENTS:** Admission requires official transcripts from each institution attended and a cumulative GPA of at least 2.0. If transferring less than 24 hours, you must also submit high school transcripts. ACT or SAT scores are not required if age 22 or over. Admission application fee is \$35.

■ **GRADUATE STUDENTS:** Admission requires official transcripts from all institutions attended, with evidence of the completed baccalaureate degree. Specific admission requirements vary according to the GPA earned during the last 60 hours of the bachelor's degree, and additional testing may be required. See the current academic catalog for specific policies on graduate admissions.
