# What to ask a University Representative

### What is your campus community like?

- Where is your college located; urban, suburban, or rural setting?
- What recreational, social, or cultural activities does your campus offer?
- Does your campus provide accessible campus parking and/or public transportation?
- Will I expect to spend most of my time on North or South campus?
- Are your classes within walking distance and does your campus have a shuttle system?
- Are you a quarter or semester school?

## What programs of study does your campus offer?

- Does your campus offer my major?
- Is your campus accredited by whom and at what level (undergraduate/graduate)?
- What is your grading system like (credit/No-credit or grades)?
- Does your campus offer internship opportunities?
- Does your campus offer an honors program and additional credit for honors courses?
- What support services do you have for students in specific fields of study?

#### When can I apply for admission?

- When and how do I apply to your campus?
- Does your campus have an early admissions program?
- What admissions requirements do you have for transfer students?
- When are students notified if they have been admitted?
- Do I need to submit my unofficial/official transcripts with my application?
- If my primary major is impacted can I apply to a secondary major?

# What is the cost-of-attendance at your campus?

- How much are registration fees, tuition, books, supplies, housing, parking, etc.
- When are fees due, should I expect additional costs, and do you payment plans?
- Do I need to purchase student health insurance or can I provide proof of my own?

### What financial aid programs/services does your campus have?

- When should I apply for financial aid and scholarships?
- Do I need to complete supplemental forms?
- When and how will I be notified if I qualify for financial aid?
- Does your campus offer University/College/Departmental assistance programs?
- Can financial aid cover my entire expenses (grants, loans, work-study, etc.)?

#### Additional questions to ask?

- Does your campus offer a study abroad?
- When can I schedule a campus tour?
- If I live on or off-campus can I purchase a meal plan?
- Does your campus provide student government opportunities?
- What type(s) of clubs/student organizations are active on-campus
