Title: Student Survey Supplementary Questions Analysis

Date of completion: September 2012

Highlights of data:

In November 2011, 3207 Vernon College students enrolled in 194 face-to-face courses completed the SIR II Survey. In April 2012, 2305 Vernon College students enrolled in 143 face-to-face courses completed the SIR II Survey. Ten additional questions were added to the survey relating specifically to student’s experiences at Vernon College. The chart below is a combined analysis of the student feedback from these questions.

Students scored each question by marking one of the following: 5-Strongly Agree; 4-Agree; 3-Neutral; 2 Disagree; 1-Strongly Disagree; 0-Not Applicable/Blank.

If more college sanctioned and organized student activities were offered in Wichita Falls at the Century City Center as the result of an additional student activity fee, I would support and participate in these student activities at CCC. **(Students who attend classes only on the Vernon campus should mark NA)**
55. Based on my total experience at Vernon College, I would recommend Vernon College to my friends and family.

Use of data:

The results retrieved detailed information for each instructor surveyed. Division Chairs, supervisors, and instructors can use the data to help identify areas of strength and areas where instructors might make some changes in the delivery and/or evaluation of course materials. The comparative data provides data by various categories to assist users in interpreting the report fully. For example, a 3.6 is numerically above average on a 5-point scale, but it may be average or even slightly below average in comparison to other means for items in SIR II.

How associated to Student Success?

As instructors improve pedagogically, it is anticipated that student success rates as measured by retention, completion, and transfer rates, will improve.
