Highlights of data: At semester checkout in December the Housing staff conducted an anonymous survey to monitor satisfaction with the Residence Halls and Food Service. Over 84% of students gave the Residence Halls positive ratings. The poorest ratings were related to the size of the rooms and the furnishings. The Food Service Survey also showed that 85% of students rated the food service either "Very Acceptable" or "Usually Acceptable". Poorest ratings were for variety of dinner menus as well as quality of vegetables.

Use of data: These surveys will be examined by the Dean of Student Services and specific topics will be addressed during future planning. Results of the food services survey will be shared with Great Western Dining (contracted food provider) so that the problem areas can be addressed.

How associated to Student Success? Providing on campus students with satisfactory living facilities and dining options helps attract students to live on campus. By living on campus, students are able to focus more on academic studies and immediately become part of the campus community.
