Highlights of data: Residence Hall Health and Safety Inspections were held on November 14, 2012. Two fines were placed for fire alarm tampering. Other minor infractions were also noted including confiscation of 2 space heaters and a warning for excessive trash. It was also noted that 2 dresser drawers in separate rooms needed to be replaced as well as one of the HVAC units. All Residence Hall staff was present and involved with room inspections.

Use of data: Results of the survey are used to maintain a safe on campus living environment. It also alerts Residence Hall staff to potential dangers and infractions they can correct.

How associated to Student Success? Maintaining a safe, affordable, and clean living environment helps students focus on their studies rather than living situation. This is the first time many of the Resident Hall students have lived away from home and often they need guidance in regards to safety and appropriate standards of living.
