Highlights of data: Each Vernon College Athletic Team (Baseball, Softball, Volleyball, and Rodeo) required student athletes to submit grade reports for all the classes each student is enrolled in. A total of 104 athletes (all VC athletes) complied with this requirement. Grade sheets are completed at least once a semester and kept in locked filing cabinets in the athletic offices.

Use of data: The coaching staff of each team met with players individually to review the grade reports. During these meetings, academic interventions for each player were discussed and agreed upon. These included increased mandatory study halls, meetings with professors, appointments with PASS center tutors, dropping classes, assignment of on team peer tutors, and the coaches involvement in individual players time management.

How associated to Student Success? This intervention helps Vernon College athletes complete and succeed in classes they are struggling in. It also reinforces the importance of academics in the role of a college athlete's tenure at Vernon College.
